At Virgin Australia, we know your clients count on being on time. We've been Australia's most punctual major airline* for four consecutive months, with 81.8% of scheduled domestic flights departing on time in March, according to the [Bureau of Transport Research and Economics report](#) released on 22 April 2025. We're proud to have achieved this result with a 4.5% increase in services compared to February 2025, to 395 daily flights in March.

Despite temporary disruption from Ex-Tropical Cyclone Alfred across key Queensland and Northern NSW airports which impacted flight completions for all major airlines broadly, Virgin Australia achieved a 98.8% scheduled domestic flight completion rate outside of this period - helping you keep your clients moving, seamlessly and on schedule.

Codeshare expansions

New Qatar Airways codeshare destinations available

Virgin Australia marketed, Qatar Airways operated codeshare has expanded to Almaty (Kazakhstan) & Marrakesh (Morocco).

Direct flights from Adelaide to San Francisco available

Our partnership with United Airlines has expanded, with your South Australian customers now able to fly to America's cultural heartland thanks to a new direct service from Adelaide to San Francisco, launching on 11 December 2025. The 15-hour direct flight, aboard a Boeing 787-9 Dreamliner, will operate three times a week until March next year, with seats now on sale via your GDS. This new route further strengthens our extensive codeshare network with United Airlines, giving Virgin Australia customers even greater access across North America.

Stopover in Bali to or from Europe

Travel agents can issue tickets to Europe on Virgin Australia and Qatar Airways with a stopover enroute in Bali. This option is available for itineraries originating in SYD, MEL or BNE. This is available on a VA code to Bali and onwards to DOH, and either a QR or VA flight number onwards to Europe.

Reminder: Corporate name changes

To take advantage of the free name change on corporate fares, the original ticket must contain a /CO /GV ticket designator or have WG at the end of the fare basis on every coupon. If the ticket is combined with a fare that is not a corporate fare, then the name change fee must be collected. Please see the [Domestic Corporate and Government Name Change Policy](#) for full information regarding fare combinability when utilising corporate fares.

Reminder: Choice fare reissuing

All Choice fares must be reissued and applicable change fee collected. Please note that any tickets revalidated instead of reissued will result in ADMs being issued.

FAQs

What should I know when combining different fare brands in one booking?

When different fare brands are combined, some fare rule categories will apply the most restrictive fare rules to all fare components of a booking. Always check the rules of each sector of your ticket to determine what the most restrictive ruling is and then apply this.
